## Meet the Locomotives: Alfred and Judy

Alfred and Judy are two very low-profile locomotives which were built for use at Par Harbour in Cornwall, UK. They had to cope with a very low bridge under the Cornish Main Line, and so the cab and all fittings were built very low and flat.

Built to replace earlier shunting locomotives, Judy was built in 1937 and Alfred in 1954 to nearly identical designs, and served until 1969 and 1977 respectively.

They were originally planned to be mass produced, but were displaced by the newer diesel shunting designs.

Both are now preserved in operational condition at the nearby Bodmin and Wenford Railway, and are used for special events.

*MTS offers these built as 'steam-outline electric' locomotives, known as the 'Vulcan' series, giving the feel of steam with the power and reliability of electric traction.*
